how to play boules

Objective

The first player to reach a total of 13 points over multiple rounds wins.

Number of players

Two to four.

How to Play

Each player/team selects a pair of balls with the same pattern to play with. For a two player game, a player will have two pairs of balls that are theirs. Mark your throwing line and toss a coin to decide who throws the small wooden target ball ("Cachonet"). Player/team 1 then throws a single ball towards the Cachonet. The next player/team then throws its balls one at a time until either they have the closest ball or all of their balls have been thrown. The next player/team then has its turn in the same fashion. After all balls have been thrown, the player/team with the ball closest to the Cachonet wins the round and scores 1 point. An extra point is also scored by the winner for every additional ball that is closer to the Cachonet than the closest ball of their opponent. e.g. If the winner has the closest, second closest and third closest balls, they score three points for that round. Rounds continue to be played until a player/team has accumulated 13 points.
